“Wanted Subject Located By Sequim Police Department, K-9 Search Results in Arrest”

On 10/01/2009 at approximately 1346 two Sequim Police Department Officers, Grant Dennis and John Southard, went to an address in the 1100 block of Fish Hatchery Road where wanted subject, Norman L. Livengood, was known to visit. Officers were looking for Livengood because he is a material witness in a trial scheduled to begin next week and he had warrants for his arrest. Livengood had just left that area on foot when officers arrived and fled from the area. Sequim Police Department Officers and Clallam County Sheriff’s Office Deputies set up containment the Sequim K-9 Unit arrived and began the track and eventually found Livengood hiding along the Dungeness River.

Sequim Police Department has been attempting to locate Livengood, a 30 year old white male, for several weeks. He is a material witness in an attempted murder trial scheduled to begin next week and he had four warrants for his arrest. Today officers arrived at the Fish Hatchery address and talked with Livengood's relative who told officers that Livengood had just left on a walk into the woods about five minutes earlier. Sequim Police Department Officer's and a Clallam County Deputy set up a containment area while K-9 was dispatched.

Sequim Police Department K-9 Officer Mike Hill and K-9 Chase began a track from the 1100 block of Fish Hatchery Road. (See photo below) The track took them approximately 300 yards through the brush where Livengood's backpack was located then they tracked across the Dungeness River onto a small island where K-9 Chase located Livengood. Livengood was hiding under brush; he was taken into custody without incident. Livengood was transported to the Clallam County Jail and booked on the warrants.
