

Fixing Windows Media Player to Play Online Content

For you self doers out there, these steps should help you correct the issue and play the video.

Step 1: Right-Click the upper left area of Windows Media Player (area highlighted in green).

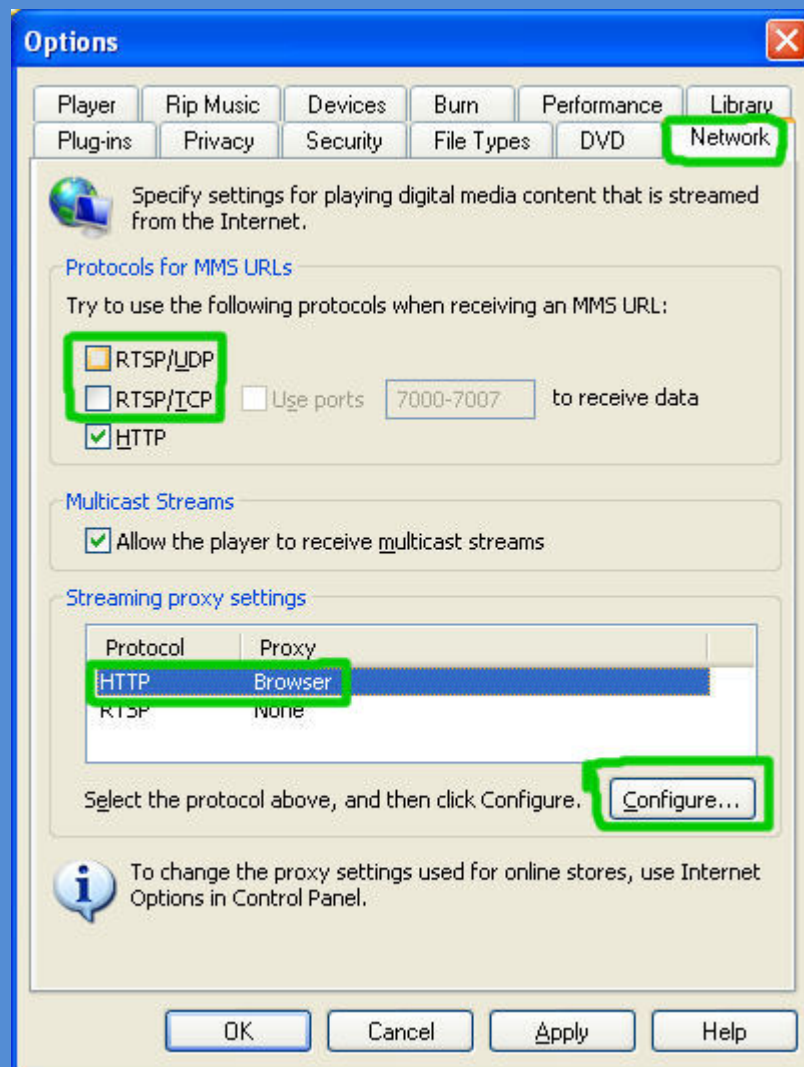
Step 2: From the drop-down menu, left-click "Tools --> Options..."

Step 3: Select the "Network" tab, and then uncheck both "RTSP" boxes.

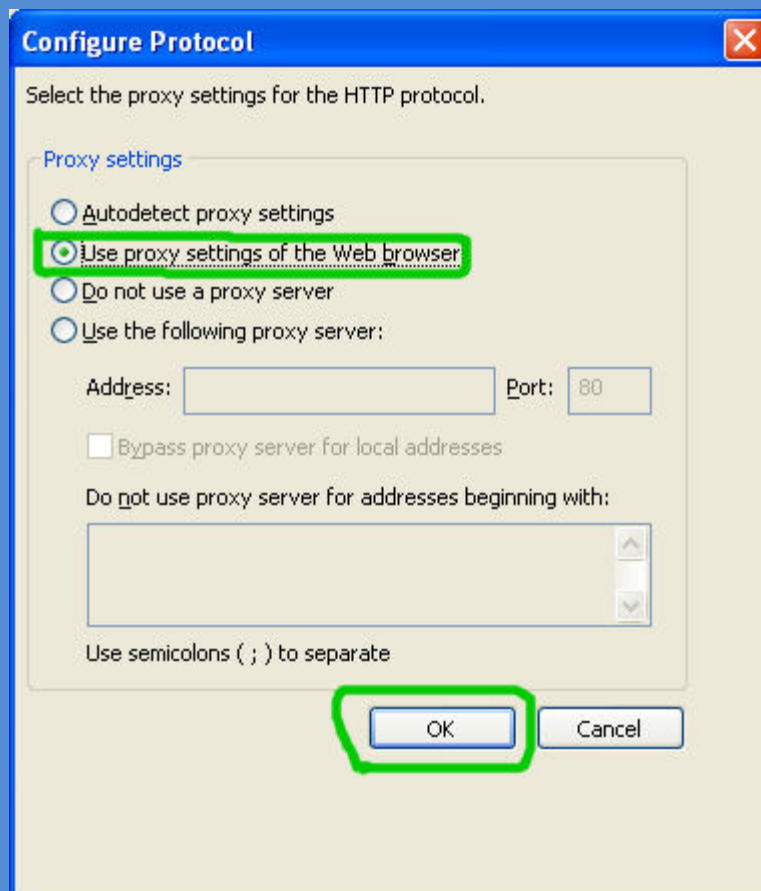
Step 4: Left-Click "HTTP Browser" and left-click the "Configure" button.

Step 5: Make sure the "Use proxy settings of the Web browser" radio button is selected.

Step 6: Click the "OK" button on this screen (Configure Protocol), and also on the remaining open previous screen (Options).



Step 7: Try to play the media file again.
